- This year we will be providing a parents/coaches class on Friday evening at the range. The majority of the USAMU Action Shooting Team is made up of professional shooters that enlisted into the US Army upon high school graduation. All were up and coming junior shooters that went through the same path that many of your juniors are currently on. We want to provide our perspectives to you all in order to fully support your junior. There is a future in shooting sports, and if that future is to be a part of the “Home of Champions” – USAMU, then we’ll tell you how to get there. Do not be afraid to ask questions, we are here to help you and your junior reach and achieve goals.

Travel

Columbus Metropolitan Airport (CSG) ///// 9 mi to Ft. Benning
Atlanta International Airport (ATL) ///// 113 mi to Ft. Benning (recommended)

Lodging

Mrs. Peel will be sending out information to the juniors and parents via email when we have a full roster.

Parents are welcome to on the range during the clinic. We ask that you keep your distance from your kids during class time. Feel free to take pictures and video. We also encourage you all to volunteer some of your time with Mrs. Peel.

Weapons: Pistol that you compete in, preferably 9mm minimum caliber (**CENTERFIRE PISTOLS ONLY**). Also bring an AR + 500rds if you would like to use your own for our rifle class. We will provide rifles if needed. We also have shotgun again this year, as it’s been a student favorite from previous years – if you have your own, please bring

300 rds. as well. If you do not have your own shotgun, we will be providing multiple Benelli M2's and VersaMax's, so each student get the equal amount of training.

YOU MUST stop at the main gate and get a pass for the weekend! Directions are attached.

Per current Fort Benning regulations, all firearms must be in locked cases separate of ammunition while being transported on the installation. Concealed carry is NOT authorized on Ft. Benning for all Service Members, DoD Civilians, and visitors with the exception of federal agents, who have the authorization to do so. Ammunition cannot be loose and must be boxed in cases. Rule of thumb – if your vehicle has a trunk or covered truck bed, place all weapons and ammunition there. If not, place all weapons and ammunition furthest to the rear from the driver's seat.

Ammo: 800-1000 pistol ammo, 500 rifle (if bringing your own rifle), 300 shotgun (if bringing your own shotgun). You can ship your ammo to the USAMU if you will be traveling by commercial plane. We do ask for at least 1000 rounds of pistol because we are having a match on Sunday to test what we have taught the juniors. You normally do not shoot all 1000, but for purposes of being close to running out of ammunition or the instructor having you shoot more than necessary, as we LOVE to shoot as well!

When wanting to ship ammo, we prefer you send it no later than September 23rd, 2016 to ensure that it arrives on time. We have had problems with parents shipping ammo to this address in the past, and you are more than welcome to ship it to the hotel you are lodging at as well. Call them ahead of time, and let them know you are expecting a package.

Equipment: competition rig (belt, holster, magazine pouches, etc.), eye pro, and ear pro.

Weather: Will vary this time of the year. It may reach down to the 40's in the morning, all the way up to the high 80's in the afternoon. Rain is possible at his time of year also. Please plan accordingly.

From Columbus, GA

Stop by the main gate to get a pass. The main gate is located at the end of I-185S. Go past exit 1A and 1B, continuing on I-185S, you will run into the gates. The building will be on the left hand side before having to go into the gates. Go in and ask for a weekend pass, stating you are here with the USAMU Action Shooting Junior Clinic. You will not be allowed to come on post without the pass.

Directions to Krilling Range:

From North Columbus

- Drive South on I185 and Exit on 1A towards CUSSETA (US 280 E/ US 27 S/ GA 520 E)
- Exit on 8th Division Rd. ACCESS POINT
- Arrive at Gate, show IDs ONLY
- At the first light, make a RIGHT ONTO 8th Division Rd.
- At the first light, make a LEFT ONTO Jamestown Rd.
- After approximately 1.5 miles, arrive at KRILLING RANGE on your right side

From Downtown Columbus

- Drive South on Veterans Pkwy and TURN LEFT onto Victory Dr. (US 280 E/ US 27 S/ GA 520 E)
- Drive approximately 9.5 miles and exit on 8th Division Rd. ACCESS POINT
- Arrive at Gate, show IDs ONLY
- At the first light, make a RIGHT ONTO 8th Division Rd.
- At the first light, make a LEFT ONTO Jamestown Rd.
- After approximately 1.5 miles, arrive at KRILLING RANGE on your right side
