 - Future Soldiers
- Contact USAMU LNO early for the possibility of coordinating a demo. Range facilities and team competition schedule must be taken into consideration for demo to happen.

 - Backdrop for up to 10'X20' indoor space
 - Equipped with weapons display and DVD presentations about USAMU.

- Request USAMU support through your unit A&PA representative NLT 6 months prior to desired event.
- Contact the USAMU LNO, SFC Kevin Heermann, at (706) 545-6677 or (888) 228-6396 or email at kevin.heermann@us.army.mil to:
 - Develop a plan for the effective use of USAMU assets
 - Mission Commander Site Recon
 - Ensure proper coordination with ranges
 - Special considerations for weapons at events
 - Acquire permissions from school officials
 - Task adequate recruiter/cadre support
 - Submit final event plans on USAAC Form 111 NLT 30 days prior to event
- Timely and thorough planning are a must for a successful event
