SFC Josh Olson is the epitome of ARMY STRONG. Olson was an infantryman patrolling the dangerous streets of northern Iraq with his squad when the enemy attacked them with rocket-propelled grenades and severely wounded SFC Olson. He had his right leg amputated, which shut the door on his days as an infantryman; it did not, however, shut the door on his days in the Army.

After 15 months of grueling rehabilitation, Olson shot his way onto the prestigious U.S. Army Marksmanship Team. More than six years after the attack, he is now one of the top ranked Paralympic shooters in the world and has his sights set on the Paralympic Games of 2012 in London. That determination is an inspiration to all of those around him, and to those he hasn't even met. SFC Olson exhibits ability rather than disability.
