B. MILPER MESSAGE 03-120, SUBJECT: DRILL SERGEANT STABILIZATIONS, DATED 1 APR 03.

1. THIS MILPER MESSAGE IS EFFECTIVE 14 OCT 03 AND WILL EXPIRE NLT APR 05.
2. DUE TO OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS ACROSS THE FORCE, THE AVAILABLE POPULATION OF SOLDIERS TO SERVE IN DRILL SERGEANT (DS) POSITIONS IS EXTREMELY LIMITED. TO HELP MAINTAIN DS READINESS, DRILL SERGEANTS WHO BEGAN PERFORMING DS DUTIES FROM 1 MAY 2002 THROUGH 30 APRIL 2003 WILL HAVE THEIR STABILIZED TOURS EXTENDED TO 36 MONTHS.
3. THE ASSIGNMENT ELIGIBILITY AND AVAILABILITY (AEA) TERMINATION DATES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ADJUSTED IN THE TOTAL ARMY PERSONNEL DATA BASE (TAPDB) BY HQDA TO REFLECT THIS INCREASED STABILIZATION.
4. REQUESTS FOR EXCEPTIONS MUST BE FORWARDED WITH APPROPRIATE JUSTIFICATION BY THE INSTALLATION DS MANAGER THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE DCS, G-1, US ARMY TRAINING AND DOCTRINE COMMAND (TRADOC) TO THE DS TEAM AT THE US ARMY HUMAN RESOURCES COMMAND (USAHRC) – ALEXANDRIA WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS MESSAGE.
5. DRILL SERGEANTS ARE REMINDED TO UPDATE THEIR FOLLOW-ON ASSIGNMENT PREFERENCES BY USING THE DS ASSIGNMENT PREFERENCE FUNCTION IN THE ASSIGNMENT SATISFACTION KEY (ASK). ASK IS AVAILABLE ONLINE AT <https://www.hrc.army.mil/>.
